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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a lease renewal (fourth of**
8 **five) with Global Tower Partners for the lease of the communications tower and building**
9 **located at 1512 East Highland Road, Twinsburg, Ohio, in Council District 1, for the 800**
10 **MHz radio system, for the period 9/1/10 to 8/31/11, in an amount not to exceed \$45,020.16,**
11 **for the Executive's Department of Law-Division of Public Safety, and declaring an**
12 **emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held July 14, 2010, awarded a lease
15 renewal (fourth of five) for the aforementioned tower and building, subject to confirmation by
16 County Council; and,

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18 WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that
19 the lease renewal is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of a lease renewal (fourth of five) with Global Tower
27 Partners for the lease of the communications tower and building located at 1512 East Highland
28 Road, Twinsburg, Ohio, in Council District 1, for the 800 MHz radio system, for the period
29 9/1/10 to 8/31/11, in an amount not to exceed \$45,020.16, is hereby confirmed and the County
30 Executive is hereby authorized to execute such lease renewal.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
36 provide the aforementioned lease renewal.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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44 SECTION 4

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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

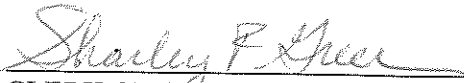
