A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1, with the International Institute of Akron, Inc., for refugee social services, as Best Practical Source, for the period 7/1/10 to 6/30/11, and appropriating \$40,000.00 (12% increase), for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held July 14, 2010, awarded a change order to provide the aforementioned services, subject to confirmation by County Council; and,

WHEREAS, additional federal Refugee Social Services Program funds were made available by Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for Summit County's refugee resettlement programming through 9/30/10; and,

WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the change order and the appropriation of the aforementioned funds in the amount of \$40,000.00 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1, with the International Institute of Akron, Inc., for refugee social services, as Best Practical Source, for the period 7/1/10 to 6/30/11, in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.00 (12% increase), is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such change order.
