7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the 2010-2011 Victims of Crime Act (“VOCA”) grant award, in the amount of**
9 **\$34,434.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$ 11,478.00, for a total of \$45,912.00,**
10 **and a 2010-2011 State Victims Assistance Act (“SVAA”) grant award for \$3,286.00, with no**
11 **local cash match requirement, both from the Ohio Office of the Attorney General, for the**
12 **period 10/1/10 through 9/30/11, and appropriating the total of 2010-2011VOCA and SVAA**
13 **funds in the amount of \$49,198.00, through 12/31/10, for the Juvenile Court, and declaring**
14 **an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Juvenile Court has been awarded a 2010-2011
17 VOCA grant award in the amount of \$34,434.00, with a local cash match requirement of
18 \$11,478.00 provided for in the General Fund, to cover salaries and benefits for a volunteer
19 coordinator to manage the services to child abuse victims that are provided through Court
20 Appointed Special Advocate (“CASA”) volunteer child advocates and court child advocates; and

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22 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Juvenile Court has been awarded a 2010-2011 SVAA
23 grant award in the amount of \$34,434.00, with no local cash match requirement for program
24 supplies; and

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26 WHEREAS, both the VOCA and the SVAA awards have been annually ongoing federal
27 pass through funding awards from the Ohio Office of the Attorney General, on the Federal Fiscal
28 Year, and this current award is for the period 10/1/10 through 9/30/11; and

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30 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
31 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute
32 any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Ohio Office
33 of the Attorney General and to appropriate these grant funds;

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35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

43 Victims Assistance Act grant award in the amount of \$3,286.00, for the period 10/1/10 through
44 9/30/11.
