7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, entitled "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Prosecutor to hire**
9 **one external person into a full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified, Attorney I position in the**
10 **criminal division, to fill a vacancy due to a resignation effective 9/10/10, up to the midpoint**
11 **of the pay range for the position, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted
14 Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary
15 Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit; and

16
17 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that
18 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and
19 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire
20 said employees; and

22 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor says it is necessary for the continued and effective operation
23 of her office to be permitted to hire a full-time Attorney I position, which is an entry-level
24 position within the Prosecutor's Office, to fill a vacancy due to a resignation effective 9/10/10,
25 up to the midpoint of the pay range for the position; and

27 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it
28 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Prosecutor
29 to hire an external person into a full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified, Attorney I position to fill
30 a vacancy due to resignation, up to the midpoint of the pay range for the position;

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
33 State of Ohio, that:

37 County Council hereby determines that the County Prosecutor has demonstrated that it is
38 necessary for the effective and continued operation of her office to authorize the County
39 Prosecutor, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinance, to hire an external person
40 into a full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified, Attorney I position, to fill a vacancy due to
41 resignation, up to the midpoint of the pay range for the position.

7 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
8 authorize the County Prosecutor to hire said individual in order to continue effectively
9 prosecuting cases and collect revenue for the County.

13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
15 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

19 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
20 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
21 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
22 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
23 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.




