7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into a Local Public Agency**
8 **agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for bridge**
9 **load ratings of the Memorial Parkway over Little Cuyahoga River, East North Street over**
10 **Little Cuyahoga, Bath Road over Cuyahoga River, Cuyahoga Street over Cuyahoga River,**
11 **Front Street over Cuyahoga River, and Kenmore Boulevard over Ohio Canal in the City of**
12 **Akron, Wooster-Robinson over Tuscarawas River in the City of Barberton, South Main**
13 **Street over Cottage Grove Lake in the City of Green, Boston Mills Road over Cuyahoga**
14 **River in Boston Township and Brandywine Road over Brandywine Creek in Northfield**
15 **Center Township, Council Districts 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, and 8, at a cost not to exceed \$38,079.00,**
16 **for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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18 WHEREAS, the Engineer finds a public need for performing bridge load ratings on the
19 Memorial Parkway over Little Cuyahoga River, East North Street over Little Cuyahoga, Bath
20 Road over Cuyahoga River, Cuyahoga Street over Cuyahoga River, Front Street over Cuyahoga
21 River, Kenmore Boulevard over Ohio Canal, Wooster-Robinson over Tuscarawas River, South
22 Main Street over Cottage Grove Lake, Boston Mills Road over Cuyahoga River and Brandywine
23 Road over Brandywine Creek in the interest of public safety; and

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25 WHEREAS, the Continuous Multi Span Bridge Load Rating Project ("Project") has been
26 selected for federal funding having received Federal High Administration ("FHWA") approval;
27 and

29 WHEREAS, the Project's estimated cost is \$38,079.00; and

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31 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation shall provide the Local Public
32 Agency 80% of the eligible costs, up to a maximum of \$30,463.20; and

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34 WHEREAS, the Engineer plans to provide the remainder of the Project's Cost, in an
35 amount not to exceed \$7,615.80; and

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37 WHEREAS, ODOT and the County of Summit Engineer desire to enter into a Local
38 Public Agency ("LPA") agreement, to confirm the Project's Cost and to designate the County of
39 Summit as the lead agency for administration of consultant selection of the Project; and

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41 WHEREAS, R.C. Sections 5501.03 (c) and 5543.01, as well as Summit County Charter
42 section 2.03 (5) allow execution of such agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

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44 WHEREAS, no funds will be expended for the Project until and unless authorized by
45 separate resolution; and

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47 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that
48 authorizing the County Executive to enter into the aforementioned LPA agreement with ODOT
49 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that:

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a Local Public Agency
10 agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for bridge load
11 ratings of the Memorial Parkway over Little Cuyahoga River, East North Street over Little
12 Cuyahoga, Bath Road over Cuyahoga River, Cuyahoga Street over Cuyahoga River, Front Street
13 over Cuyahoga River, and Kenmore Boulevard over Ohio Canal in the City of Akron, Wooster-
14 Robinson over Tuscarawas River in the City of Barberton, South Main Street over Cottage
15 Grove Lake in the City of Green, Boston Mills Road over Cuyahoga River in Boston Township
16 and Brandywine Road over Brandywine Creek in Northfield Center Township, Council Districts
17 1, 2, 4, 5, 7 and 8.

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19 SECTION 2

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21 The terms of said agreement shall include the following:

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23 a. That the parties estimate the Project's Cost to be \$38,079.00, with said cost including
24 inspection and load rating analysis;

26 b. That the net estimated cost to Summit County shall be an amount not to exceed
27 \$7,615.80; and

29 c. That Summit County shall provide all other financial resources necessary to fully
30 complete the Project.

33 SECTION 3

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35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
36 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
37 completes a prerequisite for a bridge improvement needed for safe and convenient travel within
38 the County.

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40 SECTION 4

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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46 SECTION 5

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48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
51 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
52 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
