7 **A Resolution to adjust existing appropriations within Workforce Investment Act ("WIA")**
8 **funding received from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services ("ODJFS"),**
9 **decreasing appropriations in the amount of \$388,799.00 within the WIA Rapid Response**
10 **Allocation, pursuant to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 ("ARRA"),**
11 **and increasing appropriations in the amount of \$477,000.00 for the period 7/1/10 through**
12 **3/31/11 in the WIA National Emergency Grant ("NEG") OH-22 Replenishment Funds**
13 **Allocation, for a net increase of \$88,201.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and**
14 **Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, ODJFS awarded the County Department of Job and Family Services an
17 ARRA Rapid Response Allocation grant totaling \$538,799.00, appropriated in Resolution No.
18 2009-509; and

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20 WHEREAS, the ODJFS has decreased the ARRA Rapid Response Allocation grant made
21 to the Department of Job and Family Services, reducing the allocation by \$388,799.00, for a
22 remaining balance of \$150,000.00; and

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24 WHEREAS, ODJFS had awarded the Department of Job and Family Services WIA NEG
25 OH-22 funds totaling \$100,000.00, appropriated in Resolution No. 2010-402; and

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27 WHEREAS, ODJFS has increased the WIA NEG OH-22 Replenishment Funds
28 Allocation made to the Summit County's Department of Job and Family Services, increasing the
29 allocation by \$477,000.00, for a revised total award balance of \$577,000.00; and

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31 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information
32 that the adjustments of the appropriations of the aforementioned grant funds is necessary and in
33 the best interest of the County of Summit;
