**A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into renewal contracts with County of Summit municipalities, villages, townships and other governmental entities for the provision of animal control services at the County's Animal Control Facility, for a five-year term, for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2004-188, which authorized the County Executive to execute contracts with various County of Summit municipalities, villages, townships and other governmental entities for the provision of animal control services by the County at the County's Animal Control Facility; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive executed contracts with the County of Summit municipalities, villages, townships and other governmental entities which are listed on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated, for a five-year term, with one option to renew for one additional five-year term; and

WHEREAS, as shown on Exhibit A, those contracts have or will expire within a short period of time; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends that the County of Summit enter into renewal contracts with the County of Summit municipalities, villages, townships and other governmental entities listed on Exhibit A for the provision of animal control services by the County at the County's Animal Control Facility, for a five-year term; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned renewal contracts are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

#### SECTION 1

The County Executive is authorized to enter into the renewal contracts with the County of Summit municipalities, villages, townships and other governmental entities listed on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated, for the provision of animal control services by the County at the County's Animal Control Facility, for a five-year term.

#### SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of permitting the County to provide animal control services to various County of Summit municipalities, villages, townships and other governmental entities.
