7 **A Resolution appropriating carryover balances for two U.S. Department of Justice,**
8 **Justice Assistance Grants ("JAG") made available by the State of Ohio Office of Criminal**
9 **Justice Services through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, in the**
10 **amount of \$116,951.55 for the Reentry Court Enhancement Grant and in the amount of**
11 **\$93,954.21 for a Probation Risk/Needs Assessment Grant, with total of each grant**
12 **including a 25% local match, for a grant period from 7/31/09 through 12/31/10, for the**
13 **Court of Common Pleas, and declaring an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2009-088 authorizes the County Executive to execute any
16 applications, agreements or other documents necessary to obtain funds from any agency,
17 department or office of the federal government, State of Ohio, or any political subdivision
18 thereof that are authorized by or derive from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of
19 2009 ("ARRA"); and

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21 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2009-348 appropriated funds from two U.S. Department of
22 Justice, Justice Assistance Grants ("JAG") awarded to the County of Summit by the State of
23 Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services through ARRA, in the amount of \$130,247.54 for a
24 Reentry Court Enhancement Grant and in the amount of \$93,954.21 for a Probation Risk/Needs
25 Assessment Grant, with the total of each grant including a 25% local match, for a grant period
26 from 7/31/09 through 12/31/10; and

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28 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate carryover balance for both JAG grants, in the
29 in the amount of \$116,951.55 for the Reentry Court Enhancement Grant and in the amount of
30 \$93,954.21 for a Probation Risk/Needs Assessment Grant, with total of each grant including a
31 25% local match, for a grant period from 7/31/09 through 12/31/10; and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that is it
34 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate carryover balances for
35 the aforementioned grants;
