7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a grant agreement with the**
8 **Summit County Combined General Health District to allow the District to hire a full-time**
9 **Metropolitan Medical Response System Coordinator for calendar year 2010 to support the**
10 **medical community and first responders of Summit County with planning, equipment and**
11 **training, in an amount not to exceed \$43,398.14, for the Executive's Department of Law –**
12 **Public Safety Division, Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2010-006, which
15 appropriated carryover funds in multiple grant awards including the Metropolitan Medical
16 Response System ("MMRS") Grant Program; and

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18 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 2007-192 and 2008-014, the County of Summit
19 used a private contract to act as an MMRS Coordinator, supports the medical community and
20 first responders of Summit County with planning, equipment and training; and

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22 WHEREAS, for calendar year 2010, the County wishes to provide a grant to the Summit
23 County Combined General Health District to allow the District to hire a full-time MMRS
24 Coordinator, in in an amount not to exceed \$43,398.14; and

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26 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
27 necessary to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned grant agreement with the
28 Summit County Combined General Health District;

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
31 of Ohio, that:

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33 SECTION 1

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35 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with the
36 Summit County Combined General Health District, attached hereto as Exhibit A and
37 incorporated herein as if fully restated, to allow the District to hire a full-time Metropolitan
38 Medical Response System ("MMRS") Coordinator for calendar year 2010 to support the medical
39 community and first responders of Summit County with planning, equipment and training, in an
40 amount not to exceed \$43,398.14. The Grant Agreement is approved with changes therein not
41 inconsistent with this Resolution and not substantially adverse to the County which shall be
42 approved by the County Executive; provide that the approval of those changes by the County
43 Executive and the character of such changes as not being substantially adverse to the County
44 shall be evidenced conclusively by the execution of the Grant Agreement.

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48 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
49 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
50 authorize the Executive to execute a grant agreement with the District to hire a full-time MMRS
51 Coordinator.
