5 **A Resolution amending the Report on Staffing to allow for three additional temporary**  
6 **Employment Services Counselor positions until 6/30/11, for the Executive, and declaring an**  
7 **emergency.**

8  
9 WHEREAS, the County has been the recipient of certain American Reinvestment and  
10 Recovery Act ("Stimulus") funds through the National Emergency Grant ("NEG") and the Rapid  
11 Response initiative pertaining to the closing of the Twinsburg Chrysler Plant and general job loss  
12 of automotive related jobs; and

13  
14 WHEREAS, in order to expend said NEG and Rapid Response funds, the County intends  
15 to open and operate a Transition Center in the City of Twinsburg and fund additional automotive  
16 employment transition programs out of the Job Center; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, in order to operate the aforementioned programs, the County will need to  
19 staff the facilities with four Employment Services Counselors, all of which will be temporary  
20 positions funded entirely by the aforementioned Stimulus funds; and

21  
22 WHEREAS, the County intends to post for these Employment Services Counselor  
23 positions internally only, and anticipates filling the positions either through temporary  
24 reassignment or through temporary positions for recently laid-off employees; and

25  
26 WHEREAS, the County currently anticipates funding for these positions through  
27 6/30/11; and

28  
29 WHEREAS, the Report on Staffing, approved pursuant to Resolution No. 2009-501,  
30 allows for two Employment Services Counselor positions to be employed by the Executive, only  
31 one of which is currently filled by an employee; and

32  
33 WHEREAS, in order to permit the temporary filling of the necessary number of  
34 Employment Services Counselors, the Report on Staffing will need to be amended to allow for  
35 three additional temporary Employment Services Counselor positions until 6/30/11; and

36  
37 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interest  
38 of the County to amend the Report on Staffing to allow for three additional temporary  
39 Employment Services Counselor positions until 6/30/11;

41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
42 of Ohio, that:

4 SECTION 1

5  
6 The Report on Staffing is hereby amended to allow for three additional temporary  
7 Employment Services Counselor positions until 6/30/11. The Report on Staffing shall reflect  
8 that the authorization for these positions shall expire on 6/30/11.

10 SECTION 2

11  
12 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety  
13 and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
14 allow for the posting and filling of the aforementioned positions.

15  
16 SECTION 3

17 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
18 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it shall  
19 take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

20 SECTION 4

21 It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
22 relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and  
23 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
24 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including  
25 Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
