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7 **A Resolution appropriating carryover funds for the Emergency Management program, in**
8 **the amount of \$97,032.51, through 12/31/10, for the Executive's Department of Law,**
9 **Division of Public Safety Emergency Management Agency ("EMA"), and declaring an**
10 **emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, in order to provide emergency management services to the County, the
13 EMA for the County of Summit, per agreement, receives annual per-capita funding from the
14 Summit County communities along with a 50% local cash match made by the County of
15 Summit; and

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17 WHEREAS, carryover per-capita funding and match funds exist from 2009 that require
18 appropriations for expenditures to support the county-wide emergency management
19 preparedness drill, training and resources, including fees associated with WebEOC and the
20 county-wide notification system in 2010; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
23 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned
24 carryover funds in the amount of \$97,032.51;

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26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
