5 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute OJT agreements and any necessary**  
6 **amendments to OJT agreements with various employers for participation and**  
7 **reimbursement through the Workforce Investment Act (“WIA”) On the Job Training**  
8 **Program (“OJT”), in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 collectively, through 6/30/11, for**  
9 **the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2009-355, this Council authorized the County  
12 Executive to execute agreements with various employers for participation and reimbursement  
13 through the WIA OJT, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 collectively, for the period  
14 10/1/09 to 6/30/10; and

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16 WHEREAS, following said approval, the County has entered into an OJT agreement with  
17 Plus One Communications, and desires to enter into additional OJT agreements with additional  
18 employers, whereby those employers will be reimbursed for OJT experiences provided to newly  
19 hired employees; and

21 WHEREAS, it is necessary to extend the deadline for the expenditure of said funds from  
22 6/30/10 to 6/30/11, to ensure that all of the funds allocated for the OJT program are committed  
23 and expended through the aforementioned OJT agreements; and

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25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interest  
26 of the County to authorize the Executive to execute OJT agreements and any necessary  
27 amendments to OJT agreements with various employers for participation and reimbursement  
28 through the WIA OJT program, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 collectively, through  
29 6/30/11;

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31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,  
32 State of Ohio, that:

34 SECTION 1

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36 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute OJT agreements and any necessary  
37 amendments to OJT agreements with various employers for participation and reimbursement  
38 through the WIA OJT program, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 collectively, through  
39 6/30/11. The Executive shall continue to provide to Council, on a monthly basis, a list of all  
40 employers receiving payments pursuant to those agreements, the amount of said payments and  
41 the dates that the payments are made. This Resolution shall supersede and amend the authority  
42 granted by this Council to the Executive in Resolution No. 2009-355.

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4 SECTION 2

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6 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety  
7 and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
8 authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned agreements so that WIA money may be  
9 disbursed for OJT training.

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11 SECTION 3

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13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it shall  
take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 4

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17 It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
18 relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and  
19 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
20 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including  
Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
