7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, entitled "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Executive to hire an**
9 **external person into the full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified position of Senior**
10 **Administrator-EXE, #89702, in the Department of Law, Public Safety Division, at a salary**
11 **not to exceed the midpoint of \$77,209.60 annually, to act as the Radio System**
12 **Administrator for the county-wide 800 MHz radio system, for the Executive's Department**
13 **of Law, Public Safety Division, and declaring an emergency.**

14
15 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted
16 Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary
17 Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit; and

18
19 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that
20 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and
21 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire
22 said employee; and

24 WHEREAS, on June 1, 2009, County Council approved Resolution No. 2009-245, which
25 approved the "Regional 800 MHz Radio System User Agreement," for the use and maintenance
26 of a county-wide 800 MHz radio system, and authorizing the County Executive to execute the
27 user agreement for one 10-year term, with one option to renew for an additional 5-year term,
28 with any public or private entity that wishes to use the county-wide 800 MHz radio system; and

30 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to hire an external person into the full-time
31 non-bargaining unclassified position of Senior Administrator-EXE, #89702, in the Department of
32 Law, Public Safety Division, at a salary not to exceed the midpoint of \$77,209.60 annually, to
33 act as the Radio System Administrator for the county-wide 800 MHz radio system; and

35 WHEREAS, there is an available vacancy in the position of Senior Administrator-EXE in
36 the Executive's Office pursuant to the Staffing Report for 2009/2010 approved by this Council
37 through the adoption of Amended Resolution 2009-501; and

39 WHEREAS, the position of Senior Administrator-EXE shall be compensated through
40 user fees paid by entities participating in the county-wide 800 MHz radio system, including the
41 County and the City of Akron; and

43 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it
44 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive
45 to hire an external person into the full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified position of Senior
46 Administrator-EXE, #89702, in the Department of Law, Public Safety Division, at a salary not to
47 exceed the midpoint of \$77,209.60 annually, to act as the Radio System Administrator for the
48 county-wide 800 MHz radio system;

50 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
51 State of Ohio, that:

4 SECTION 1

6 County Council hereby determines that the County Executive has demonstrated that it is
7 necessary for the effective and continued operation of his office to authorize the County
8 Executive, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinance, to hire an external person
9 into the full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified position of Senior Administrator-EXE, #89702, in
10 the Department of Law, Public Safety Division, at a salary not to exceed the midpoint of
11 \$77,209.60 annually, to act as the Radio System Administrator for the county-wide 800 MHz
12 radio system, within the Executive's 2010 targeted budget.

14 SECTION 2

16 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
17 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
18 authorize the County Executive to hire a Senior Administrator-EXE in order to continue to
19 effectively administer county-wide 800 MHz radio system.

21 SECTION 3

23 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
24 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
25 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

29 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
30 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
31 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
32 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
33 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
