7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 for the**  
8 **Radio Systems Administrator for the City-County Regional 800 MHz system, with Robert**  
9 **Scarlatelli, for the period 5/1/09 to 10/31/09, in an amount not to exceed \$12,976.00 (50%**  
10 **increase), for an accumulative total of \$38,926.00, for the Executive's Department of Law –**  
11 **Division of Public Safety/Justice Affairs, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, on June 1, 2009, County Council approved Resolution No. 2009-245, which  
14 approved the "Regional 800MHz Radio System User Agreement," for the use and maintenance  
15 of a county-wide 800 MHz radio system, and authorizing the County Executive to execute the  
16 user agreement for one 10-year term, with one option to renew for an additional 5-year term,  
17 with any public or private entity that wishes to use the county-wide 800 MHz radio system; and

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19 WHEREAS, a six-month agreement between the County of Summit and Robert  
20 Scarlatelli for services as a Radio System Administrator for the City-County Regional 800 MHz  
21 trunked radio communication system, from 5/11/09 through 11/10/09, in an amount not to  
22 exceed \$4,325.00 per month, or \$25,950.00 for the six-month term of the agreement, was  
23 executed effective 5/11/09; and

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25 WHEREAS, County Council ratified the agreement with the adoption of Resolution No.  
26 2009-349; and

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28 WHEREAS, Mr. Scarlatelli performed additional services from 11/1/09 through  
29 12/31/09, in the amount of \$12,976.00 (50% increase); and

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31 WHEREAS, the City of Akron will pay the County funds in the amount of \$12,976.00  
32 for payment for Mr. Scarlatelli's additional services; and

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34 WHEREAS, the County will not pay the invoice, attached hereto as Exhibit A and  
35 incorporated herein as if fully restated, until it has received said funds from Akron; and

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37 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 28, 2010, awarded a change  
38 order for the aforementioned services, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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40 WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that  
41 the change order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

48 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 for the Radio Systems  
49 Administrator for the City-County Regional 800 MHz system, with Robert Scarlatelli, for the  
50 period 5/1/09 to 10/31/09, in an amount not to exceed \$12,976.00 (50% increase), for an  
51 accumulative total of \$38,926.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby  
52 authorized to execute such change order.

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SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide the aforementioned services.

SECTION 3




