7 **A Resolution appropriating funds in the amount of \$855,635.13 in carryover balances for**
 8 **2011, in various awards and agreements, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

10 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor has a carryover balance of \$473,975.60 in federal funds from
 11 the U.S. Department of Justice for Domestic Violence Program; and

13 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor has a carryover balance of \$72,114.46 in an award from the
 14 Ohio Attorney General's Office of federal funds for the Victims of Crime ("VOCA") and State
 15 Victim Assistance ("SVAA") grant programs; and
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17 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor has a carryover balance totaling \$7,677.85 in awards from
 18 various funds within the Akron Community Foundation; and
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20 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Direct Indictment Program has executed agreements from
 21 Akron, Barberton, Copley, New Franklin, and Norton totaling \$301,867.22 in; and,
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23 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these carryover funds from 2010 for 2011
 24 operations; and
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26 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the
 27 aforementioned appropriations, in the amount of \$855,635.13 are necessary and in the best
 28 interest of the County of Summit;

34 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
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

10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


