6 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for the improvement**
7 **of Akron-Peninsula Road, located in Boston Township and the Village of Peninsula,**
8 **Council District 1, at an estimated total cost to the County of Summit not to exceed**
9 **\$510,000.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, an improvement is proposed for approximately 1.16 miles of Akron-
12 Peninsula Road, from approximately 1,000 feet south of Truxell Road (C.H. 187) to Orchard
13 Street (located approximately 500 feet south of State Route 303 in the Village of Peninsula),
14 including pavement and shoulder resurfacing, said road section being located in Boston
15 Township, and the Village of Peninsula; and

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17 WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of the project is \$510,000.00, with \$475,000.00 of
18 said cost to be funded by Public Lands Highway Discretionary funds, and with the remaining
19 \$35,000.00 to be borne by the County of Summit, of which \$35,000.00 is 100% County Engineer
20 funds; and

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22 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
23 requires Council approval for the County Executive to advertise for bids for projects that are
24 included in the Engineer's 2010 Capital Improvement Program; and

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26 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that is
27 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to
28 advertise for bids for the Akron Peninsula Road Improvement Project;

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
31 of Ohio, that;

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33 SECTION 1

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35 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the improvement of Akron-
36 Peninsula Road, located in Boston Township and Village of Peninsula, Council District 1, at a
37 total estimated cost to the County of Summit not to exceed \$510,000.00.

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39 SECTION 2

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41 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
42 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately expedites
43 roadway improvements that will increase the safety and ease of highway use.

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45 SECTION 3

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47 Provided this resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
48 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
49 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


