7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Memorandum of**
8 **Understanding with Metro SWAT and Portage County setting forth the use of,**
9 **maintenance of and the duties of the parties concerning a TAG RDV F59 Edition command**
10 **vehicle to be jointly purchased by Summit County and Portage County for their respective**
11 **emergency management agencies and housed by Metro SWAT at the City of Twinsburg**
12 **Service Department, for the Executive's Department of Law, Division of Public Safety—**
13 **Emergency Management, and declaring an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, there is legislation currently pending before this Council which confirms an
16 award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with The Armored Group, LLC, for a TAG
17 RDV F59 Edition command vehicle, under Federal GSA pricing, in an amount not to exceed
18 \$78,121.50, for the Executive's Department of Law – Division of Public Safety/Emergency
19 Management; and

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21 WHEREAS, the total cost of the vehicle is \$117,182.25, of which two-thirds of the cost,
22 or \$78,121.50, will be paid by Summit County and one-third of the cost, or \$39,060.75, will be
23 paid by Portage County; and

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25 WHEREAS, the vehicle will be titled to Summit County, but housed by Metro SWAT by
26 Metro SWAT at the City of Twinsburg Service Department, and will be used by Metro SWAT
27 ("Special Weapons and Tactics"), which is comprised of 15 communities in Summit County and
28 Portage County; and

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30 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the County Executive to execute a Memorandum of
31 Understanding with Metro SWAT and Portage County setting forth the use of, maintenance of
32 and the duties of the parties concerning a TAG RDV F59 Edition command vehicle; and

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34 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
35 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute
36 the aforementioned Memorandum of Understanding with Metro SWAT;

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38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
39 of Ohio, that:

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43 The County Executive is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with
44 Metro SWAT and Portage County setting forth the use, maintenance of and the duties of the
45 parties concerning a TAG RDV F59 Edition command vehicle to be purchased by Summit
46 County and Portage County.

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6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency to provide for the protection of the
7 health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and to immediately allow the
8 Executive to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Metro SWAT and Portage County
9 setting forth the use of, maintenance of and the duties of the parties concerning a TAG RDV F59
10 Edition command vehicle.

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12 SECTION 3

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14 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
15 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
16 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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18 SECTION 4

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20 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
21 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
22 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
23 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
24 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
