7 **A Resolution appropriating funds in the amount of \$38,079.00, including a local cash**
8 **match requirement in the amount of \$7,615.80, from Motor Vehicle and Gas Tax funds,**
9 **into a separate capital project fund, for the Continuous Multi Span Bridge Load Project, in**
10 **Council Districts 1, 2, 4, 5, 7 and 8, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Continuous Multi Span Bridge Load Rating Project ("Project") has been
13 selected for federal funding having received Federal Highway Administration ("FHWA")
14 approval; and

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16 WHEREAS, the Project's estimated cost is \$38,079.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation shall provide the Local Public
19 Agency 80% of the eligible costs, up to a maximum of \$30,463.20; and

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21 WHEREAS, the County Engineer plans to provide the remainder of the Project's Cost, in
22 an amount not to exceed \$7,615.80; and

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24 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2010-472 authorized the Executive to enter into a Local
25 Public Agency agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation; and

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27 WHEREAS, the Engineer finds a public need for performing bridge load ratings on the
28 Memorial Parkway over Little Cuyahoga River, East North Street over Little Cuyahoga, Bath
29 Road over Cuyahoga River, Cuyahoga Street over Cuyahoga River, Front Street over Cuyahoga
30 River, Kenmore Boulevard over Ohio Canal, Wooster-Robinson over Tuscarawas River, South
31 Main Street over Cottage Grove Lake, Boston Mills Road over Cuyahoga River and Brandywine
32 Road over Brandywine Creek, in Council Districts 1, 2, 4, 5, 7 and 8, in the interest of public
33 safety; and

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35 WHEREAS, the Project will require appropriations in the amount of \$38,079.00 into a
36 separate capital project fund and appropriations in the Motor Vehicle and Gas Tax Fund to
37 provide the local cash match requirement in the amount \$7,615.80; and

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39 WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that
40 the aforementioned appropriations are necessary and in the best interest of the County of
41 Summit;
