A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute agreements for five Energy Efficiency Conservation Block Grant ("EECBG") projects, funded by an American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 ("ARRA") award from the U.S. Department of Energy, and adjusting the existing EECBG appropriations by \$156,636.00, through 12/31/11, for the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit received \$2,698,800.00 in EECBG from the U. S. Department of Energy through ARRA, which this Council appropriated pursuant to Resolution No. 2009-512; and

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2011, the Community Development Block Grant Review Committee approved five grant projects, in the amount of \$156,636.00, to be funded by the said EECBG monies; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the County Executive to execute agreements for the aforementioned projects; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute agreements for the five EECBG grant projects, and to authorized the necessary adjustments to the EECBG fund appropriations within this grant award;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute agreements for five grant projects, in the amount of \$156,636.00, as shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated, to be funded by the Energy Efficiency Conservation Block Grant monies received by the County of Summit from the U. S. Department of Energy, through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the Executive to execute agreements for necessary EECBG projects and for the further reason that the adjustment to the appropriations is needed for the EECBG Program.

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
