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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a collective bargaining**
8 **agreement between Ohio Council 8 and Local 3885 of the American Federation of State,**
9 **County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and the County Prosecutor, Child Support**
10 **Enforcement Agency, for the period of October 1, 2011 to September 30, 2014, for the**
11 **Executive and Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been reached between the County
14 Prosecutor, Child Support Enforcement Agency, Ohio Council 8 and Local 3885 of the
15 American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, for the period
16 October 1, 2011 to September 30, 2014; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that
19 the aforementioned collective bargaining agreement is necessary and in the best interest of the
20 County of Summit;

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22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
23 State of Ohio, that:

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25 SECTION 1

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27 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement
28 between Ohio Council 8 and Local 3885 of the American Federation of State, County and
29 Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and the County Prosecutor, Child Support Enforcement
30 Agency, for the period of October 1, 2011 to September 20, 2014.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of providing all
36 immediate collective bargaining agreement between Ohio Council 8 and Local 3885 of the
37 American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and the County
38 Prosecutor, Child Support Enforcement Agency.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
8 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
9 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
