7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute, on behalf of the County**  
8 **Prosecutor's Child Support Enforcement Agency ("CSEA"), an Intergovernmental**  
9 **Agreement with Summit County Children Services ("SCCS") and any other documents**  
10 **necessary to transfer \$483,461.00 from the Tobacco Use Prevention and Control**  
11 **Foundation Endowment Fund allocation to CSEA for use during the period of July 1, 2010**  
12 **through June 30, 2011 to fund CSEA's ongoing operations, for the Executive and**  
13 **Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, SCCS is the recipient of Tobacco Use Prevention and Control Foundation  
16 Endowment Funds, which it has received as a one time allocation pursuant to an allocation notice  
17 from the State, whereby the State set forth the allocation for the Tobacco Use Prevention and  
18 Control Foundation Endowment Fund for the time period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011;

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21 WHEREAS, CSEA is currently facing a shortfall in funding as a result of the  
22 discontinuation of federal matching funds; and

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24 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has permitted SCCS's allocation from the Tobacco Use  
25 Prevention and Control Foundation Endowment Fund to be utilized by CSEA to fund its ongoing  
26 operations; and

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28 WHEREAS, SCCS and the County Executive, on behalf of CSEA, intend to enter into an  
29 intergovernmental agreement in order for SCCS to transfer the sum of \$483,461.00 from its  
30 Tobacco Use Prevention and Control Foundation Endowment Fund allocation to CSEA; and

32 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2011-159, which provides  
33 for a transfer of \$483,461.00 in Temporary Assistance to Need Families ("TANF") Title XX  
34 funds from the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services to SCCS as substitute  
35 funding for the Tobacco Use Prevention and Control Foundation Endowment Fund allocation;

37 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
38 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute  
39 the aforementioned intergovernmental agreement and any other documents necessary to transfer  
40 \$483,461.00 from the Tobacco Use Prevention and Control Foundation Endowment Fund to  
41 CSEA;

43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
44 of Ohio, that:

4 SECTION 1

6 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the County Prosecutor's  
7 Child Support Enforcement Agency ("CSEA"), an Intergovernmental Agreement with Summit County  
8 Children Services ("SCCS") and any other documents necessary to transfer  
9 \$483,461.00 from the SCCS's Tobacco Use Prevention and Control Foundation Endowment Fund  
10 allocation to CSEA for used during the period for use during the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30,  
11 2011 to fund CSEA's ongoing operations.

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13 SECTION 2

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15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare  
16 of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the transfer of  
17 said funds from the Tobacco Use Prevention and Control Foundation Endowment Fund allocation to  
18 CSEA to fund its ongoing operations.

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20 SECTION 3

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22 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect  
23 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in  
24 force at the earliest time provided by law.

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28 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
29 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
30 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
31 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
32 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
