7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a contract with Brite**
8 **Computers, subject to the approval of the Information and Technology Board and the**
9 **Board of Control, for the purchase of 60 Fujitsu Mobile Data Terminals for law**
10 **enforcement agencies in Homeland Security Region 5, under the Western States**
11 **Contracting Alliance (“WSCA”) between Fujitsu and the State of Ohio, in an amount not**
12 **to exceed \$201,960.00, which will be fully funded using the Fiscal Year 2008 Law**
13 **Enforcement-State Homeland Security Program (“FY08 LE-SHSP”) grant, for the**
14 **Executive’s Department of Law, Division of Public Safety-Justice Affairs, and declaring an**
15 **emergency.**

17 WHEREAS, the County wishes to enter into a contract with Brite Computers for the
18 purchase of 60 Fujitsu Mobile Data Terminals for law enforcement agencies in Homeland
19 Security Region 5 under the WSCA between Fujitsu and the State of Ohio, in an amount not to
20 exceed \$201,960.00, which will be fully funded using the FY08 LE-SHSP grant; and

22 WHEREAS, because the contract is for a purchase of equipment through a public
23 cooperative public purchasing association, pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(11) of the Codified
24 Ordinances of the County of Summit, competitive bidding is not required; and

26 WHEREAS, the approval of the Information and Technology Board and the Board of
27 Control will be required; and

29 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
30 necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute the
31 aforementioned contract with Brite Computers, subject to the approval of the Information and
32 Technology Board and the Board of Control;

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
35 of Ohio, that:

39 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Brite Computers,
40 subject to the approval of the Information and Technology Board and the Board of Control, for
41 the purchase of 60 Fujitsu Mobile Data Terminals for law enforcement agencies in Homeland
42 Security Region 5 under the Western States Contracting Alliance (“WSCA”) between Fujitsu
43 and the State of Ohio, in an amount not to exceed \$201,960.00, which will be fully funded using
44 the Fiscal Year 2008 Law Enforcement-State Homeland Security Program (“FY08 LE-SHSP”)

15 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
16 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
