7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for roadway**  
8 **engineering and construction projects, bridge engineering and construction projects, and**  
9 **pavement maintenance projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$3,610,400.00, for**  
10 **the County Engineer's 2011 Capital Improvement Program, for the Engineer, and**  
11 **declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, Resolution 2011-017 of this Council previously approved the County's  
14 2011 Capital Improvement Program, which includes highway and bridge improvements for the  
15 Engineer; and

17 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
18 requires this Council's authorization to advertise for bids for said improvements; and

20 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that is  
21 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit that the County Executive be  
22 authorized to advertise for bids for County highway improvements listed in the County  
23 Engineer's 2011 Capital Improvement Program;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

30 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the following categories of  
31 infrastructure improvements:

35 2011 Pavement Maintenance Program \$1,490,000.00

39 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare  
40 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately provides  
41 for necessary improvements to the County's highway system.

45 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
47 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
