10 **Executive’s Division of Public Safety - Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an**

13 WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency awarded a State Fiscal Year
14 2008 SHSP Regional Hazmat grant to the County of Summit Emergency Management Agency,
15 which was accepted and appropriated in Resolution No. 2010-007; and

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17 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate the balance of carryover funds in the amount
18 of \$2,698.02 for equipment which will support the Hazardous Materials Response Teams within
19 the Northeast Central Ohio (“NECO”) Region V; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the
22 aforementioned appropriation in the amount of \$2,698.02 is necessary and in the best interest of
23 the County of Summit;

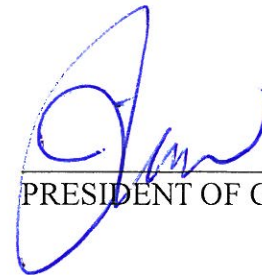
