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7 **A Resolution appropriating additional federal grant funds received from the Ohio**
8 **Department of Public Safety for the countywide Fiscal Year 2011 (“FY 2011”) Operating a**
9 **Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated (“OVI”) Task Force program, in the amount of**
10 **\$18,872.47, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 5/1/11 to 9/30/11, for the**
11 **Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, through the Governor’s Highway
14 Safety Office, provided \$206,392.05 in grant funding, for a countywide FY 2011 OVI Task
15 Force program, to the County of Summit Sheriff’s Office, which was accepted and appropriated
16 in Resolution No. 2010-446, for the period 10/1/10 to 9/30/11, in order to conduct high visibility
17 enforcement, public awareness, and education for alcohol-related crashes and traffic related
18 fatalities; and

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20 WHEREAS, County of Summit Sheriff’s Office has received a grant revision for the FY
21 2011 OVI Task Force program, for additional funding in the amount of \$18,872.47, from the
22 Ohio Department of Public Safety; and

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24 WHEREAS, the additional funds will provide for the purchase of one pull-behind trailer,
25 light towers, generator, and other equipment for the Sheriff’s patrol vehicles; and

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27 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
28 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned
29 funds in the amount of \$18,872.47;
