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5 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute agreements and amendments to existing**
6 **agreements with various local employers for participation and reimbursement through the**
7 **Workforce Investment Act (“WIA”) On the Job Training (“OJT”) program, in an amount**
8 **not to exceed \$500,000.00 collectively, for the period of 7/1/11 to 6/30/12, for the Executive’s**
9 **Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2009-355, this Council authorized the County
12 Executive to execute agreements with various employers for participation and reimbursement
13 through the WIA OJT program, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 collectively, for the
14 period of 10/1/09 to 6/30/10; and

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16 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2010-209, this Council extended the timeframe
17 to enter into said agreements and expend said WIA OJT funds until 6/30/11; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Department of Job and Family Services anticipates that said WIA OJT
20 funds will be expended by 6/30/11, but desires to continue the program with an additional
21 \$500,000.00 in WIA OJT funding, in order to continue reimbursing current and additional
22 employers for newly hired employees, for the period of 7/1/11 to 6/31/12; and

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24 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determined that it is necessary and in the best interest
25 of the County to authorize the Executive to execute agreements and amendments to existing
26 agreements with various local employers for participation and reimbursement through the WIA
27 OJT program, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 collectively, for the period of 7/1/11 to
28 6/30/12.

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
31 State of Ohio, that:

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33 SECTION 1

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35 The County executive is hereby authorized Executive to execute agreements and
36 amendments to existing agreements with various local employers for participation and
37 reimbursement through the WIA OJT program, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00
38 collectively, for the period of 7/1/11 to 6/30/12.

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40 SECTION 2

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42 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
43 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately allow
44 the Executive to enter into the any necessary agreements and amendments prior to the period set
45 forth above.


