7 **An Ordinance amending Section 165.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**  
8 **Summit, entitled “Board of Trustees; Members,” which sets forth the membership of the**  
9 **Summit-Akron Solid Waste Management Authority, to change the reference to Summit**  
10 **County Township Clerks Association to Township Association of Summit County, to**  
11 **reflect a name change and to make other minor non-substantive changes, for the Executive,**  
12 **and declaring an emergency.**

13  
14 WHEREAS, Section 165.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit,  
15 entitled “Board of Trustees; Members,” sets forth the membership of the Summit-Akron Solid  
16 Waste Management Authority; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, because Ohio law was changed to allow townships to have fiscal officers,  
19 the Summit County Township Clerks Association has changed its name to the Township  
20 Association of Summit County; and

21  
22 WHEREAS, because of the aforementioned name change, it is necessary to amend  
23 Section 165.02 to change the reference to the Association; and

24  
25 WHEREAS, it is necessary to further amend Section 165.02 to change the reference to  
26 the Health Director of Summit County to the Health Director of the Summit County Combined  
27 General Health District, the correct name of the County’s health district; and

28  
29 WHEREAS, it necessary to further amend Section 165.02 to make other minor non-  
30 substantive changes; and

31  
32 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
33 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to make the aforementioned  
34 amendments to Section 165.02;

35  
36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
37 of Ohio, that:

39 SECTION 1

40  
41 Section 165.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled “Board of  
42 Trustees; Members,” is hereby amended as follows:

44 **“165.02 BOARD OF TRUSTEES; MEMBERS.**

45 (a) All Trustees herein appointed shall be residents of ~~Summit~~ the County of Summit,  
46 Ohio. The Summit- Akron Solid Waste Management Authority Board of Trustees shall have all  
47 the powers and duties enumerated in ~~Ohio R.C.~~ Chapters 343 and 3734 of the Ohio Revised  
48 Code, and shall consist of the following members:

4 SECTION 1 (cont'd.)

6 (1) Three (3) trustees appointed by the City of Akron, one (1) of whom shall  
7 be the Mayor of Akron;

8 (2) Two (2) trustees appointed by the County of Summit, one (1) of whom  
9 shall be the County Executive;

10 (3) One (1) trustee appointed by the ~~Summit County Township Clerks~~  
11 ~~Association~~ Township Association of Summit County;

12 (4) One (1) trustee representing the cities of Summit County excluding the  
13 City of Akron, appointed by the Summit County Mayor's Association;

14 (5) One (1) trustee representing the villages of Summit County, appointed by  
15 the Summit County Mayor's Association;

16 (6) The Health Directors of the Summit County Combined General Health  
17 District and the City of Akron; and

18 (7) One (1) trustee chosen by the other ten (10) trustees who is not a public  
19 official.

20 (b) Of the total number of Trustees appointed by the County of Summit, (Section  
21 2(b), (f)) one (1) shall be a resident of the City of Akron.”

22  
23 SECTION 2

24  
25 This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety  
26 and welfare of the citizens of the county of Summit, Ohio, and for the further reason is that it is  
27 necessary in order to immediately amend Section 165.02 to change the reference to Summit  
28 County Township Clerks Association to Township Association of Summit County to reflect a  
29 name change and to make other minor non-substantive changes.

31 SECTION 3

32  
33 Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
34 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
35 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

37 SECTION 4


