7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute the first and final renewal of a**
8 **five-year interlocal agreement with the City of Akron for sharing costs, revenues, facilities**
9 **and resources related to the countywide 800 MHz regional radio system, for the**
10 **Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public**
11 **Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the City of Akron have established a countywide
14 800 MHz regional radio system to coordinate interoperability and communications for public
15 safety departments and other users for the benefit of County residents; and

16
17 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2006-209, which approved
18 the five-year interlocal agreement with the City of Akron for sharing costs, revenues, facilities
19 and resources related to the countywide 800 MHz radio system, with one option to renew for an
20 additional five-year term; and

21
22 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2005-385, which approved
23 the form of the "Regional 800 MHz Radio System User Agreement," for the use and
24 maintenance of a countywide 800 MHz radio system, and authorizes the County Executive to
25 execute the user agreement for one ten-year term and one five-year renewal with any County of
26 Summit political subdivision, the counties of Cuyahoga, Medina, Portage, Stark or Wayne or
27 political subdivisions located in those counties, that wish to use the countywide 800MHz radio
28 system; and

30 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the County of Summit and the City of Akron to execute
31 the first and final renewal of a five-year interlocal agreement for sharing costs, revenues,
32 facilities and resources related to the countywide 800 MHz radio system; and

34 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that
35 authorizing the Executive to execute the aforementioned renewal with the City of Akron is
36 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
39 of Ohio, that:

43 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the first and final renewal of a
44 five-year interlocal agreement with the City of Akron for sharing costs, revenues, facilities and
45 resources related to the countywide 800 MHz radio system.

6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
7 welfare of the citizens and employees of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it
8 is necessary in order to authorize the Executive to immediately execute the renewal of an
9 interlocal agreement with the City of Akron for sharing costs, revenues, facilities and resources
10 related to the countywide 800 MHz radio system.

14 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
15 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
16 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

20 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
21 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
22 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
23 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
24 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


