7 **An amended Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order**  
8 **No. 4 with The Goodwill Industries of Akron, Ohio, Inc., for the second and final renewal,**  
9 **for the Job Center employment services for Workforce Investment Act ("WIA") eligible**  
10 **adult and dislocated workers, and second extension for the period 7/1/10 to ~~11/30/11~~**  
11 **12/31/11, in an amount not to exceed ~~\$162,431.18~~ \$243,646.77 (14% 21% increase), for the**  
12 **Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 14, 2011, awarded a  
15 change order provide the aforementioned services, subject to confirmation by County Council;

18 WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that  
19 the change order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

26 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 4 with The Goodwill Industries  
27 of Akron, Ohio, Inc., for the second and final renewal, for the Job Center employment services  
28 for Workforce Investment Act ("WIA") eligible adult and dislocated workers, and second  
29 extension for the period 7/1/10 to ~~11/30/11~~ 12/31/11, in an amount not to exceed ~~\$162,431.18~~  
30 \$243,646.77 (14% 21% increase), is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby  
31 authorized to execute such change order.

35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
36 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
37 provide the aforementioned services.

39 SECTION 3

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41 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
42 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
43 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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47 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
48 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
49 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
50 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
51 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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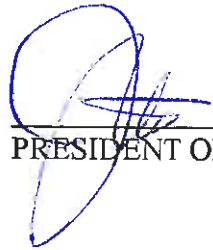
