7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to participate in, and execute all documents**
8 **necessary to participate in, an application to the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation**
9 **Study for funding of the Eastern Road corridor study, in Council District 7, and to**
10 **authorize the County's local match in an amount not to exceed \$6,000.00, for the**
11 **Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an**
12 **emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the County Executive, along with the City of New Franklin, City of
15 Barberton, City of Norton and Wayne County desire to conduct a transportation improvement
16 study of the Eastern Road corridor between State Route 619 and State Route 585, in Council
17 District 7; and

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19 WHEREAS, said Eastern Road corridor study will focus on improvements that will
20 reduce the number of crashes in that corridor, improve pavement conditions and complete a
21 currently uncompleted segment of Eastern Road; and

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23 WHEREAS, the parties desire to apply for Federal Surface Transportation, Congestion
24 Mitigation/Air Quality or Transportation Enhancement Program Funds that are programmed
25 through the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study ("AMATS") for the Eastern Road
26 corridor study, which is estimated to cost \$150,000.00; and

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28 WHEREAS, AMATS Funding Policy Guidelines require a local match from the
29 participating communities, and the County's share of the local match will not exceed \$6,000.00;
30 and

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32 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development
33 intends to fund the County's local match from Community Development Block Grant funds, or
34 other eligible funds appropriated to the Executive's Office; and

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36 WHEREAS, the Eastern Road corridor study is important for the future development of
37 the southwestern portion of Summit County and improving traffic and road conditions in the
38 Eastern Road corridor; and

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40 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
41 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to participate
42 in, and execute all documents necessary to participate in, an application to AMATS for funding
43 of the Eastern Road corridor study, and to authorize the County's local match in an amount not
44 to exceed \$6,000.00;

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The County Executive is hereby authorized to participate in, and execute all documents
7 necessary to participate in, an application to Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study for
8 funding of the Eastern Road corridor study through Federal Surface Transportation, Congestion
9 Mitigation/Air Quality or Transportation Enhancement Program Funds, and to authorize the
10 County's local match in an amount not to exceed \$6,000.00.

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety
15 and welfare of the citizens of the County and for the further reason to immediately authorize the
16 Executive to execute necessary documents so that the application can be timely submitted prior
17 to the deadline for submittal set by AMATS.

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21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
22 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be
23 in force at the earliest time provided by law.


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25 SECTION 4
