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7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, entitled "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Executive to hire**
9 **one person into a full-time, non-bargaining unit, classified, Engineering Intern position,**
10 **Category 1, Grade 5, at the Department of Environmental Services, at an annual salary not**
11 **to exceed \$32,177.60, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and**
12 **declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which
15 enacted Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled
16 "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit, and Ordinance
17 No. 2011-204, which reinstated the hiring freeze through December 31, 2012; and

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19 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
20 provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that the filling of an existing position by
21 hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and continued operation of the office, Council
22 may adopt a resolution authorizing the office to hire said employees; and

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24 WHEREAS, at the County Executive's Department of Environmental Services
25 ("DOES"), an Environmental Engineer 2 is a full-time, non-bargaining unit, classified position
26 resigned; and

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28 WHEREAS, DOES requires an employee that will perform duties in support of the
29 Engineering Department of DOES including computer-aided design, that are necessary for the
30 continued and effective operation of DOES; and

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32 WHEREAS, the County Executive states that the available position of Engineering Intern
33 has been posted internally and that his office has not been able to hire a qualified candidate into
34 the position, and that it is necessary for the continued and effective operation of DOES for the
35 Executive to be permitted to hire one external person into the Engineering Intern position, at an
36 annual salary not to exceed \$32,177.60 and

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38 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
39 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
40 Executive to hire one external person into the full-time, non-bargaining, classified Engineering
41 Intern position at DOES, at an annual salary not to exceed \$32,177.60;

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,

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4 SECTION 1

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6 County Council hereby determines that the County Executive has demonstrated that it is
7 necessary for the effective and continued operation of the Executive's Department of
8 Environmental Services ("DOES") to authorize the Executive, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of
9 the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, to hire one external person into a full-time,
10 non-bargaining, classified, Engineering Intern position, Category 1 Grade 5, at DOES, at an
11 annual salary not to exceed \$32,177.60.

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13 SECTION 2

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15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
16 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose to authorize the
17 County Executive to hire said individual to satisfy an immediate need of support in the
18 Engineering department of DOES, including Computer Aided Design work.

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20 SECTION 3

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22 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
23 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
24 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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26 SECTION 4

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28 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
29 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
30 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
31 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
32 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


