7 **A Resolution appropriating carryover funds in various grant awards, in an amount**  
8 **totaling \$1,296,898.95, for the period 1/1/12 through 12/31/12, for the Prosecutor, and**  
9 **declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, the County Prosecutor's Office has grant awards which were appropriated in  
12 fiscal year 2011 and which now have carryover balances which require appropriations in fiscal  
13 year 2012; and

14  
15 WHEREAS, these grants include three Domestic Violence ("DV") grants including a DV  
16 training grant, the DV federal grant for 2011-2013, and the DV federal grant for 2005-2011  
17 which was granted an extension; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, carryover balances also exist in the 2011-2012 Victims of Crime Act  
20 ("VOCA/SVAA") grant, the Direct Indictment Program, and the Child Support Enforcement  
21 Agency's ("CSEA's") Special Improvement Project grant; and

23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
24 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the  
25 aforementioned funds, in the amount of \$1,296,898.95;

19 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
20 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

21 SECTION 5

22 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
23 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
24 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
25 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
26 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


