7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a six-month policing contract**
8 **with the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority to provide four Sheriff's Deputies and**
9 **three vehicles, for the period 1/1/12 through 6/30/12, in a total amount not to exceed**
10 **\$196,854.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2009-330, which authorized
13 the County Executive to enter into a policing contract with the Akron Metropolitan Housing
14 Authority ("AMHA") to provide four Sheriff's Deputies, from 7/1/09 through 12/31/11, in an
15 amount not to exceed \$955,570.50; and

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17 WHEREAS, the aforementioned agreement expired on 12/31/11; and

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19 WHEREAS, AMHA has requested that the County Executive execute a new agreement
20 to provide four Sheriff's Deputies and three vehicles, for the period 1/1/12 through 6/30/12; and

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22 WHEREAS, AMHA has agreed to pay the County the amount of \$32,809.00 per month
23 for total of \$196,854.00, for the six-month period from 1/1/12 through 6/30/12, and

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25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
26 that the aforementioned agreement is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
29 of Ohio, that;

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31 SECTION 1

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33 The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a six-month policing contract
34 with the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority to provide four full-time Sheriff's Deputies and
35 three vehicles, for the period 1/1/12 through 6/30/12, for the total amount of \$196,854.00 during
36 the term of the agreement.

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38 SECTION 2

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40 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
41 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
42 providing necessary policing to AMHA beginning 1/1/12.

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44 SECTION 3

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46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
48 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
