7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to disburse funds exceeding an aggregate of**  
8 **\$25,000.00 for calendar year 2012 for state-approved providers and state-contractors for**  
9 **Workforce Investment Act Individual Training Accounts for both Summit and Medina**  
10 **Counties, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an**  
11 **emergency.**

12  
13 WHEREAS, Section 177.21 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
14 requires the approval of this Council for all contracts with a vendor exceeding \$25,000.00 in the  
15 aggregate in any calendar year which are funded by State of Ohio or federal pass-through dollars  
16 for which the County has no discretion in selecting the vendor; and

18 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS")  
19 coordinates and monitors the training of eligible Summit and Medina County Workforce  
20 Investment Act ("WIA") clients through state-approved WIA training providers via multiple  
21 Individual Training Accounts, which are funded by WIA pass-through funds from the federal  
22 government; and

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24 WHEREAS, the County has no discretion in the selection of the WIA training providers,  
25 which are approved by the State and selected by the WIA client; and

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27 WHEREAS, it is anticipated that during calendar year 2012, certain WIA training  
28 providers will provide Individual Training Account services to multiple clients, which will  
29 collectively exceed the amount of \$25,000.00; and

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31 WHEREAS, because it is not possible for the County to determine which WIA training  
32 providers will exceed \$25,000.00 during the calendar year until the clients select the training  
33 providers and the County is presented with invoices, this Council has, in recent years, provided  
34 pre-approval for any vendor appearing on the State-approved list; and

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36 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
37 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County, to authorize the Executive to disburse  
38 pass-through funds exceeding \$25,000.00 to all State-approved WIA Individual Training  
39 Account providers.

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41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,  
42 State of Ohio, that:

46 The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter agreements and disburse funds  
47 exceeding an aggregate of \$25,000.00 to all State-approved WIA Individual Training Account  
48 providers, for payments for Individual Training Accounts for Summit County clients during  
49 calendar year 2012.

4 SECTION 2

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6 The County Executive is hereby authorized to disburse funds, as the fiscal agent for  
7 Medina County, exceeding an aggregate of \$25,000.00 to all State-approved WIA Individual  
8 Training Account providers, for payments for Individual Training Accounts for Medina County  
9 clients during calendar year 2012.

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11 SECTION 3

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13 The Executive shall provide to the Clerk of Council, in electronic or written format, a  
14 complete listing of all State-approved WIA Individual Training Account providers who have  
15 received pass-through funds from the County during calendar year 2012, on a monthly basis, no  
16 later than the first day of each month.

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18 SECTION 4

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20 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety  
21 and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary to  
22 immediately authorize payment to the aforementioned vendors.

24 SECTION 5



27 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be  
28 in force at the earliest time provided by law.
