8 **contract with Proware, Inc., for design and integration software for the existing case**
9 **management system to handle kiosk reporting for low risk offenders, as Best Practical**
10 **Source, approved by the IT Board on 2/9/12, in the amount of \$77,604.00, and**
11 **appropriating the Justice Reinvestment-Probation Improvement Technology and Training**
12 **Grant from the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Corrections, in the amount of**
13 **\$199,100.00, for operations through 12/31/12, for the Court of Common Pleas-General**
14 **Division, Adult Probation Department, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the Adult Probation Department has received a Justice Reinvestment-
17 Probation Improvement Technology and Training Grant, from the Ohio Department of
18 Rehabilitation and Corrections, in the amount of \$199,100.00 for operations through 12/31/12;

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21 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held February 22, 2012, awarded a
22 professional service contract with Proware, Inc., for design and integration software for the
23 existing case management system to handle kiosk reporting for low risk offenders, as Best
24 Practical Source, approved by the IT Board 2/9/12, in the amount of \$77,604.00, subject to
25 confirmation by County Council; and

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27 WHEREAS, the adoption of Evidence Based Practices will focus the proper services for
28 probationers based on their level of risk as determined by the Ohio Risk Assessment System
29 ("ORAS"); and

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31 WHEREAS, this grant, accepted in Resolution No. 2012-021, for a probation reporting
32 program for non-residential reporting of low to medium risk offenders, is designed to enhance
33 reporting by the implementation of kiosk reporting stations in strategic locations throughout
34 Summit County, and to provide for staffing and staff training; and

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36 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
37 that the aforementioned contract and the appropriation of the aforementioned grant funds is
38 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
