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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into agreements with various**
8 **employers that may individually exceed the sum of \$25,000.00 for direct employment of**
9 **certain youth during a youth employment program operated by the Executive's**
10 **Department of Job and Family Services during the period 6/1/12 through 8/31/12, for the**
11 **Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("County
14 DJFS") has received notice of an allocation from the Ohio Department of Job and Family
15 Services ("Ohio DJFS") of Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") funds in the
16 amount of \$1,236,917.14 for a summer youth employment program; and

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18 WHEREAS, the aforementioned allocation has been provided to the County in order to
19 fund a summer employment program for certain TANF-eligible Summit County youth aged 14-
20 24; and

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22 WHEREAS, pursuant to a contemporary Resolution, this Council has accepted the
23 aforementioned funds and appropriated the same; and

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25 WHEREAS, the County DJFS desires to institute a program using the aforementioned
26 allocation whereby certain TANF-eligible youth meeting certain requirements will be employed
27 during the period 6/1/12 through 8/31/12; and

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29 WHEREAS, the County DJFS intends to contract directly with several employers
30 whereby those employers will hire the TANF-eligible youth and the County will then reimburse
31 the employers for the wages and benefits paid to those youth employees; and

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33 WHEREAS, the County DJFS anticipates that some of the aforementioned employers
34 may receive more than \$25,000.00 in funds that will be used to reimburse those employers for
35 the costs of the wages and benefits of the aforementioned youth employees; and

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37 WHEREAS, in order to expend the summer youth program funds in a timely manner, it is
38 necessary and prudent to provide authorization to the County Executive to enter agreements with
39 the aforementioned employers for the reimbursement of the costs of the wages and benefits for
40 the aforementioned youth when said agreements exceed \$25,000.00; and

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42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
43 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to
44 execute agreements with various employers that may individually exceed \$25,000.00 for the
45 reimbursement of the costs of the wages and benefits for the aforementioned youth.

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47 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
48 State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into agreements with various employers that may individually exceed \$25,000.00 for the reimbursement of the costs of the wages and benefits for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families-eligible youth during a youth employment program operated by the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services during the period 6/1/12 through 8/31/12.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to allow the Executive to enter into the aforementioned agreements in a timely manner in order to properly expend the aforementioned summer youth program funds.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


