7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Prosecutor to hire**
9 **one external person into a full-time, non-bargaining unit Computer Systems/Software**
10 **Analyst 1 position in the Child Support Enforcement Agency of the Prosecutor's Office to**
11 **fill a vacant position, at a rate of \$19.01 per hour, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an**
12 **emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted
15 Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary
16 Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit and Ordinance No. 2011-204,
17 which reinstated the hiring freeze through December 31, 2012; and

18
19 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that
20 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and
21 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire
22 said employees; and

24 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor says it is necessary for the continued and effective operation
25 of her Child Support Enforcement Agency to be permitted to hire and fill one external person
26 into full-time, non-bargaining unit Computer Systems/Software Analyst 1 position; and

28 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
29 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
30 Prosecutor to hire one external person into a full-time, non-bargaining unit Computer
31 Systems/Software Analyst 1 position at a rate of \$19.01 per hour;

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
34 State of Ohio, that:

38 County Council hereby determines that the County Prosecutor has demonstrated that it is
39 necessary for the effective and continued operation of her office to authorize the County
40 Prosecutor, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinance, to hire one external person
41 into a full-time, non-bargaining unit Computer Systems/Software Analyst 1 position at a rate of
42 \$19.01 per hour;

46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
47 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
48 authorize the County Prosecutor to hire one external person into a full-time, non-bargaining unit
49 Computer Systems/Software Analyst 1 position in order to continue effectively establishing and
50 enforcing child support orders and collecting support for families in Summit County.

8 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


