7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **VT Hackney for a hazardous materials emergency support vehicle, in an amount not to**
9 **exceed \$256,643.00, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk**
10 **Management, Division of Public Safety/Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Special Operations Response Teams ("SORT") have
14 determined that it is necessary to purchase a hazardous materials emergency support vehicle (the
15 "Vehicle") for use by SORT as it would serve as a replacement for the current vehicle that is
16 being retired as it has reached the end of its useful life and which is necessary in order for the
17 Hazardous Materials Response Team to remain a Type 1 Regional Response Resource; and

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19 WHEREAS, funding for the Vehicle has been allocated as follows: City of Akron--
20 \$10,000.00; EM Special Project Grant (2011)--\$29,561.50; Domestic Preparedness
21 (Metropolitan Medical Response System Grant)--\$122,000.00; and from the SORT Budget--
22 \$109,500, for a total amount of \$271,061.50; and

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24 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2012-234, which authorized
25 the County Executive to advertise for bids for the Vehicle, for an estimated total cost not to
26 exceed \$270,000.00; and

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28 WHEREAS, the County Executive advertised in the Akron Beacon Journal and
29 forwarded notice of the opportunity to bid to four specialty vehicle manufacturers; and

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31 WHEREAS, only one vendor, VT Hackney Inc., submitted a bid for the Vehicle, in the
32 amount of \$256,643.00; and

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34 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held July 25, 2012, awarded a purchase
35 contract to VT Hackney for the Vehicle, in an amount not to exceed \$256,643.00, subject to the
36 approval of Council; and

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38 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
39 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to confirm the award by the
40 Board of Control of a purchase contract to VT Hackney for the Vehicle, in an amount not to
41 exceed \$256,643.00;

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
44 of Ohio, that:

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48 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with VT Hackney for a
49 hazardous materials emergency support vehicle, in an amount not to exceed \$256,643.00, is
50 hereby confirmed and the County Executive is authorized to execute said contract.

8 awarding said purchase contract to VT Hackney because some grant funding expires 7/31/12 and
9 the vendor requires sufficient time to construct and deliver the vehicle.

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13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
15 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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19 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
20 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
21 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
