7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an agreement with the City of**
8 **Akron for the County's participation in Akron's drug and alcohol testing agreement with**
9 **SUMMA Health System, d.b.a. SUMMA Center for Corporate Health, for the term 9/1/12**
10 **through 12/31/13, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk**
11 **Management, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the City of Akron entered into an agreement with SUMMA Health System,
14 d.b.a. SUMMA Center for Corporate Health, an Ohio non-profit corporation ("SUMMA"), for
15 the provision of certain professional services to provide the collection, testing, and medical
16 review services for drug and alcohol testing; and

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18 WHEREAS, Akron has offered the County the opportunity to fully participate in the
19 Akron's drug and alcohol testing agreement with SUMMA, for the term 9/1/12 through
20 12/31/13, which will reduce costs and increase the efficiency of operations for both Akron and
21 the County; and

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23 WHEREAS, in order for the County to participate in Akron's drug and alcohol testing
24 services, it is necessary for the City and County to execute an agreement setting forth the duties
25 and responsibilities of the parties and binding the County to the terms and conditions of Akron's
26 agreement with SUMMA; and

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28 WHEREAS, Section 177.07(a)(10) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
29 authorizes the County to participate in "[c]ontracts for the acquisition of utilities, equipment,
30 materials, supplies or services upon the same financial terms as a contract entered into by another
31 political subdivision of the State of Ohio provided that the contract entered into by the other
32 political subdivision was awarded pursuant to a request for proposals or a competitive selection
33 procedure of that political subdivision;" and

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35 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
36 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
37 Executive to execute an agreement with Akron for the County's participation in Akron's drug
38 and alcohol testing agreement with SUMMA for the term 9/1/12 through 12/31/13;

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40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

43 SECTION 1

45 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the City of
46 Akron for the County's participation in Akron's drug and alcohol agreement with SUMMA
47 Health System, d.b.a. SUMMA Center for Corporate Health ("SUMMA") for the term 9/1/12
48 through 12/31/13. The Executive is hereby authorized to pay the drug and alcohol testing fees
49 set forth in Akron's agreement with SUMMA for testing of County employees.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately authorize the Executive to execute an agreement with Akron for the County's participation in Akron's agreement with SUMMA for drug and alcohol testing and realize immediate savings and efficiency.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4


