WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 12, 2012, awarded a professional service contract with Keefe Group to operate the Jail Commissary for a one-year period, with four options to renew for an additional one-year period, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Keefe Group to operate the Jail Commissary for a one-year period, with four options to renew for an additional one-year period, in an amount not to exceed the highest jail commissary commission rate of 34.5%, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for the agreement effective 10/1/12.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4
