7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept a 2012 National Court Appointed Special Advocates Association award of a Jewelers**
9 **for Children CASA grant in the amount of \$39,000.00, supplemented with local funds in**
10 **the amount of \$20,946.33, for a total amount of \$59,946.33, for the period 10/1/12 through**
11 **9/30/13, and appropriating these funds for CASA expenditures through 12/31/12, for the**
12 **Court of Common Pleas - Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the National Court Appointed Special Advocates Association ("National
15 CASA") is a nonprofit organization which offers consultation and resources to help provide
16 programs for abused and neglected children; and

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18 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Juvenile Court maintains a CASA program, and
19 funds from this grant help to support the CASA Volunteer Coordinator position which sees that
20 every child who enters the system as a result of allegations of abuse, neglect or dependency will
21 be provided with a trained volunteer to advocate in court for what is in the child's best interest;
22 and

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24 WHEREAS, National CASA has awarded the Juvenile Court a sustainability grant of
25 private funds from the Jewelers for Children, in the amount of \$39,000.00, for the period 10/1/12
26 through 9/30/13, which will be supplemented with \$20,946.33 in current Juvenile Court funds;
27 and

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29 WHEREAS, the local supplement is available within the Court's IV-E funds appropriated
30 in the 2012 Permanent Budget and received as reimbursement funds for children placed in the
31 Juvenile Court system; and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
34 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
35 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the
36 National CASA, and to appropriate grant funds;

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38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

36 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
