7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept**
8 **an award of a grant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety - Office of Criminal Justice,**
9 **for a countywide Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated Task Force Program, in the**
10 **amount of \$208,449.60 in federal funds, with no local cash match requirement, for the period**
11 **10/1/12 through 9/30/13, confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order, in**
12 **the amount of \$111,560.57, for various law enforcement agencies for the Task Force for the**
13 **period 10/1/12 through 9/30/13, and appropriating the grant funds for the period 10/1/12**
14 **through 12/31/12, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, through the Office of Criminal Justice
17 Services ("OCJS"), has awarded the County Sheriff a grant, in the amount of \$208,449.60 in federal
18 funds, for a countywide Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated ("OVI") Task Force Program
19 in order to conduct high visibility enforcement, public awareness, and education for alcohol-related
20 crashes and traffic-related fatalities in the County of Summit, for the period 10/1/12 through 9/30/13;

23 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held 9/26/12, awarded a purchase order, in
24 the amount of \$111,560.57, for payments to various law enforcement agencies for OVI Task Force
25 services, for the period 10/1/12 through 9/30/13, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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27 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate all grant funds for the period 10/1/12 through
28 12/31/12; and

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30 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that
31 it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to
32 execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned OCJS grant, to approve the award by
33 the Board of Control of the purchase order for payments to law enforcement agencies OVI Task
34 Force services and to appropriate grant funds;

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36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of
37 Ohio, that:

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41 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept a
42 grant award in the amount of \$208,449.60, in federal funds, with no local cash match requirement,
43 from the Ohio Department of Public Safety - Office of Criminal Justice Services, for a countywide
44 Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated ("OVI") Task Force Program, for the period 10/1/12
45 through 9/30/13.

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49 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order for payments to various law
50 enforcement agencies for the OVI Task Force, for the period 10/1/12 through 9/30/13, in an amount
51 not to exceed \$111,560.57, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to
52 execute such purchase orders.

43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
44 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be
in force at the earliest time provided by law.
