7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk**  
8 **Management, to make expenditures, in an amount not to exceed \$7,500.00, for hospitality**  
9 **items incurred in providing training sessions to be held in 2012, for the Executive's**  
10 **Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk  
13 Management conducts training, including health fairs and worksite wellness conferences, for the  
14 County of Summit ; and

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16 WHEREAS, such training sessions are attended by county employees, outside  
17 organizations and elected officials; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management  
20 wishes to pay hospitality expenses in an amount not to exceed \$7,500.00 for 2012 related to the  
21 aforementioned training sessions, some of which will be reimbursed from Medical Mutual  
22 wellness dollars and some of which is paid by conference attendees, sponsors and vendors; and

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24 WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Ohio issued Opinion No.  
25 82-006, which authorizes the expenditure of funds by a local political subdivision for its  
26 employees as long as those expenditures are necessary to further a public purpose and if the  
27 political subdivision's determination to make such expenditures is not manifestly arbitrary or  
28 unreasonable; and

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30 WHEREAS, Section 177.24 (b) and (c) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of  
31 Summit require the approval of County Council for hospitality expenditures exceeding \$2,000.00  
32 per year and for hospitality expenditures for purposes other than employee training, meetings and  
33 organization strategic planning meetings; and

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35 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
36 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize and ratify the  
37 Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management expenditures, in an amount  
38 not to exceed \$7,500.00, for hospitality items incurred in providing training sessions to be held in  
39 2012 and that such expenditures are for a valid public purpose;

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41 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
42 of Ohio, that:

44 SECTION 1

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46 The County Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management is hereby  
47 authorized to make expenditures, in an amount not to exceed \$7,500.00, for hospitality items  
48 incurred in providing training sessions to be held in 2012. This Council hereby finds and  
49 determines that such expenses are for a valid public purpose.  
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SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately authorizing and ratifying Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management expenditures for hospitality items incurred in providing training sessions to be held in 2012.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
