7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**  
8 **contract with Children's Hospital Medical Center of Akron, Division of Adolescent**  
9 **Medicine, to provide physician and medical services for the Court of Common Pleas –**  
10 **Juvenile Division, for the period 1/1/13 through 12/31/13, in an amount not to exceed**  
11 **\$204,406.00, for the Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division, and declaring an**  
12 **emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 10, 2012, awarded a  
15 professional service contract with Children's Hospital Medical Center of Akron, Division of  
16 Adolescent Medicine, to provide physician and medical services for the Court of Common Pleas  
17 – Juvenile Division, for the period 1/1/13 through 12/31/13, subject to confirmation by County  
18 Council; and

20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
21 that the contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
24 of Ohio, that:

26 SECTION 1

28 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Children's  
29 Hospital Medical Center of Akron, Division of Adolescent Medicine, to provide physician and  
30 medical services for the Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division, for the period 1/1/13  
31 through 12/31/13, in an amount not to exceed \$204,406.00, is hereby confirmed and the County  
32 Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract.

36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
38 provide for the services effective 1/1/13.

42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
50 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
51 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
52 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
