7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2 to a**  
8 **professional service contract with The University of Akron Institute for Health and Social**  
9 **Policy for additional evaluation services for the Family Support Matters grant, in an**  
10 **amount not to exceed \$5,923.00 (31.51% increase from the original contract and 131.44%**  
11 **cumulative increase), for the Prosecutor's Child Support Enforcement Agency, and**  
12 **declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 6, 2013, awarded Change  
15 Order No. 2 to a professional service contract with The University of Akron Institute for Health  
16 and Social Policy for additional evaluation services for the Family Support Matters grant, in an  
17 amount not to exceed \$5,923.00 (31.51% increase from the original contract and 131.44%  
18 cumulative increase), subject to confirmation by County Council; and

20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, by reviewing all pertinent information,  
21 that the change order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
24 of Ohio, that:

28 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2 to a professional service  
29 contract with The University of Akron Institute for Health and Social Policy for additional  
30 evaluation services for the Family Support Matters grant, in an amount not to exceed \$5,923.00  
31 (31.51% increase from the original contract and 131.44% cumulative increase), is hereby  
32 confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such change order.

36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
38 provide additional evaluation services for the Family Support Matters grant in 2013.

42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
50 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

52 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
