7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept a Temporary Assistance for Needy Families award of federal funds, from the Ohio**
9 **Department of Job and Family Services, of a 2013 Summer Youth Employment Program**
10 **grant, for the period 4/1/13 through 8/31/13, in the amount of \$1,641,547.00, with no local**
11 **cash match requirement, and appropriating the total of \$1,641,547.00 for expenditures in**
12 **2013, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services and declaring an**
13 **emergency.**

15 WHEREAS, the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services (“SCJFS”) has
16 received an award of federal funds from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services
17 (“ODJFS”), for a 2013 Summer Youth Employment Program grant of Temporary Assistance for
18 Needy Families (“TANF”) funds, in the amount of \$1,641,547.00, with no local cash match
19 requirement; and

21 WHEREAS, this TANF funding will support the 2013 Summer Youth Employment
22 Program which will operate from 5/15/13 through 8/31/13; and

24 WHEREAS, the 2013 Summer Youth Employment Program will provide low income
25 TANF-eligible youths the opportunity to gain valuable work experience while earning a
26 paycheck; and

28 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
29 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
30 immediately execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant
31 from ODJFS, and to appropriate these grant funds;

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
34 of Ohio, that:

38 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
39 the award of a 2013 Summer Youth Employment Program grant from the Ohio Department of
40 Job and Family Services (“ODJFS”), for the period 5/15/13 through 8/31/13, in the amount of
41 \$1,641,547.00, with no local cash match requirement.
