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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with**  
8 **METRO Regional Transit Authority for 2,760 31-day bus passes for youth participating in**  
9 **the Summer Youth Employment Program, for the period 5/1/13 through 8/31/13, as Best**  
10 **Practical Source, in an amount not to exceed \$138,000.00, for the Executive's Department**  
11 **of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 24, 2013, awarded a purchase  
14 order with METRO Regional Transit Authority for 2,760 31-day bus passes for youth  
15 participating in the Summer Youth Employment Program, for the period 5/1/13 through 8/31/13,  
16 as Best Practical Source, subject to confirmation by County Council; and,

18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
19 that the purchase order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
22 of Ohio, that:

26 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with METRO Regional Transit  
27 Authority for 2,760 31-day bus passes for youth participating in the Summer Youth Employment  
28 Program, for the period 5/1/13 through 8/31/13, as Best Practical Source, in an amount not to  
29 exceed \$138,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to  
30 execute such purchase order.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
36 provide bus passes for eligible youth effective 5/1/13.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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44 SECTION 4

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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.  
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
