7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract renewal (first of two) with Medical Mutual of Ohio (Express Scripts) to serve as**
9 **the pharmacy benefits manager and to operate the mail-order pharmacy program on**
10 **behalf of the County, for the period 1/1/14 through 12/31/14, at an administrative cost of**
11 **\$.75 per prescription, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk**
12 **Management, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on August 21, 2013, awarded a
15 professional service contract renewal (first of two) with Medical Mutual of Ohio (Express
16 Scripts) to serve as the County's pharmacy benefits manager and to operate a mail-order
17 pharmacy on behalf of the County, for the period 1/1/14 through 12/31/14, subject to
18 confirmation by County Council; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve the renewal;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
24 State of Ohio, that:

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26 SECTION 1

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28 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract renewal (first of
29 two) with Medical Mutual of Ohio (Express Scripts) to serve as the pharmacy benefits manager
30 and to operate the mail-order pharmacy program on behalf of the County, for the period 1/1/14
31 through 12/31/14, at an administrative cost of \$.75 per prescription, is hereby confirmed and the
32 Executive is authorized to execute such renewal.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately enter
38 into said agreement so that the County has a pharmacy benefits manager and mail-order
39 pharmacy in place when the current term expires on 12/31/13.

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41 SECTION 3

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
