7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a renewal of a cooperative**
8 **agreement with the City of Akron for an additional term of five years, whereby the County**
9 **and Akron share the County's office services facilities, share the expenses of equipment**
10 **and combine purchase of supplies, for the Executive's Department of Finance and Budget,**
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2008-468, this Council authorized the County
14 Executive to execute a cooperative agreement with the City of Akron to share the County's
15 office services facilities, share the expenses of equipment and combined purchase of supplies for
16 the period of five years, with a renewal term of five years; and

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18 WHEREAS, the County and City of Akron desire to renew said agreement for an
19 additional five-year period; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
22 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to enter into a
23 cooperative agreement with the City of Akron whereby the County and the City of Akron shall
24 share the expenses of equipment, facilities and combining their purchase of supplies for Office
25 Services;

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27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a renewal of a cooperative
33 agreement with the City of Akron whereby the County and the City of Akron share the expenses
34 of equipment, facilities and combine their purchase of supplies for Office Services.

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36 SECTION 2

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38 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
39 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it will
40 immediately authorize the County Executive to execute said renewal to the cooperative
41 agreement and continue to realize substantial cost savings for the County.

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43 SECTION 3

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45 Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
47 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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4 SECTION 4

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6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related
7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in open meeting of this Council, and that all
8 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
9 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section
10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
