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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for the rehabilitation**
8 **of two owner-occupied group homes and the replacement of a shared driveway, in the City**
9 **of Stow, in Council District 3, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$123,500.00, for the**
10 **Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
14 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the rehabilitation of
17 two owner-occupied group homes and the replacement of a shared driveway, in the City of Stow,
18 in Council District 3; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
22 advertise for bids for the aforementioned project;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that;

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the rehabilitation of two
30 owner-occupied group homes and the replacement of a shared driveway, in the City of Stow, in
31 Council District 3, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$123,500.00.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
36 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
37 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the rehabilitation of two owner-occupied group
38 homes and the replacement of a shared driveway in the City of Stow in Council District 3.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
